ENJOY YEAR ROUND, EASY BACK DOOR ACCESS

Pleasure any time you want it - that's what your hot tub affords you. It's like your own world class resort, right in the comfort of your own back yard. That's why it's best to situate your hot tub as close to your home access door as possible. Keeping your hot tub within ten feet of a patio or sundeck door will help you make the most of your Beachcomber during cool or freezing weather. **Keep your Beachcomber close to your back door so that enjoyment is ready for you, in any weather.**

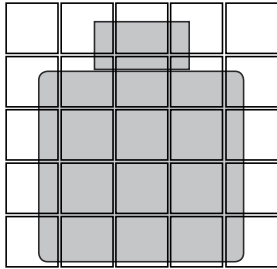
If you are planning to have your deck surround your hot tub, always make sure to have the hot tub on site before any cuts are made. Every hot tub is hand built and dimensions may vary slightly. For in-deck installations it's always best to measure your actual hot tub you purchased to ensure that it will fit perfectly.

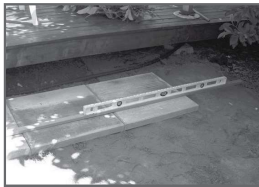
LAYING YOUR FOUNDATION

It's very important to have your hot tub placed on a flat, level spot that will support the weight over the long term. We don't recommend placing a hot tub directly on unprepared ground; proper materials are widely available, such as patio blocks from your local building center. They are easy to lay down with sand, a perimeter border, a long, straight board, and a level.

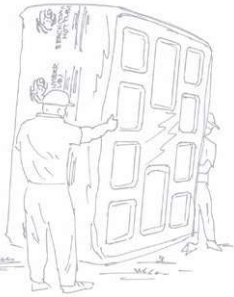
Using a level between your blocks as you lay them down helps to ensure that your spot remains level and flat. Ensure that your spot is laid out and ready to go before the delivery crew arrives.

Your local store will call you to confirm your preferred location before the delivery date is arranged.

There are different shapes and sizes of patio blocks available at most building centers. Shown here are the 24"/61cm blocks. If your hot tub is a Hybrid3 Edition, ensure to leave enough room for the SafeAxis™ Steps. Measure to accommodate any other extras you may want. Your Beachcomber Hot Tub can sit on just about any flat, level surface.



Installing a hot tub on a deck is a popular location for many home owners. Before placing on or in your deck, consult your local store for exact measurements and building code information for proper weight support.



GROUND PREPARATION FOR YOUR NEW BEACHCOMBER

A Beachcomber Hot Tub is fully portable. If you move, simply take it with you. It's a fully integrated unit: all you need is a flat, level spot, an electrical line and water from your garden hose.

Even though it's not required, some go to the extra expense to have a cement pad poured. This can be an attractive foundation that will last indefinitely. Your Beachcomber store expert can recommend one of these simple ways to prepare the ground for your hot tub.



PERMA-SEAL™ - THE QUALITY FINISHING TOUCH

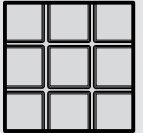

Preparing to set up Your new Hot Tub



WATER ACCESS IS EASY - JUST USE YOUR OUTDOOR GARDEN HOSE

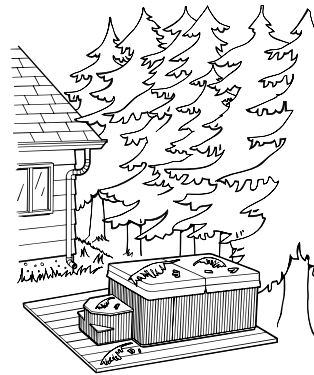
Filling your Beachcomber is easy. You don't need any specially treated water — simply place your garden hose in the hot tub, and fill it up. Having easy access to the garden hose from your house makes it convenient for you to fill and drain. The Beachcomber Owner's Guide gives you all the information you need to use and care for your hot tub.

Use the easy instructions included with your new hot tub for more information. It's very easy to care for and requires very little maintenance. And with water care programs that make sense and are easy to use, you will get the most from your hot tub without worrying about a lot of maintenance.

HOT TUB PLACEMENT

Your Beachcomber store has a Site Survey Template Kit that they can bring to your home to measure the space for your new hot tub. Whether it's on a deck or on a pad, this is a simple and effective way to plan where your hot tub will go. Ask your store for an in-home inspection. Your local building code will give you the requirements for proper support of your hot tub on a wood deck. The average size filled hot tub filled can weigh more than the car in your driveway. It must be supported properly to ensure a safe and reliable installation.

Our recommendation has always been to install your hot tub outside on a deck or on a pad. But if you do decide to install it in the home, ensure that your contractor provides proper ventilation according to your local building code.



PLANNING YOUR BACK YARD FOR THE BEST EXPERIENCE

Get the relaxation and calm that you need in this busy world, by planning your hot tub location for the best privacy.

If there are trees or fences that may be replaced or moved in the future, consider what your environment will be like. Look at the direction you will be facing, from neighboring windows, doors, trees or fences. Your hot tub location is very important to optimize your soaking, relaxing environment for you and your family.

Trees leave deposits behind, from sap, pods, needles, leaves, or branches. Take a close look at your installation spot to ensure that your hot tub is placed far enough from tree cover.

KEEP YOUR HOT TUB CLOSE TO YOUR BACK DOOR

Make sure that you get the very most from your hot tub investment. Keeping your hot tub close to your back door or patio will make it easy to use your hot tub.

If you have farther to go, you may find that it will deter you from using the hot tub. Ensure that you place it just steps away, so that you can enjoy it in any weather.



From our experience as hot tub users ourselves, you will get more enjoyment from your hot tub when it's about 10 feet from your back door for quick and easy access.

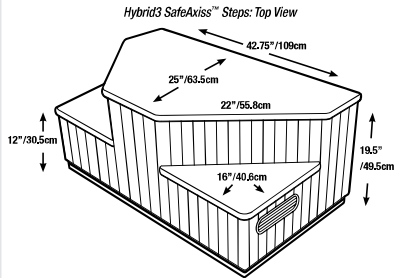


Beachcomber Hot Tubs fall under one of these five area dimensions shown below; never cut the hole in a deck until your hot tub arrives.

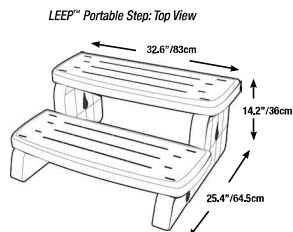

Below are the dimensions of the Hybrid4 step, and the LEEP step to help you plan your space, to locate your hot tub in your back yard.



The SafeAxis Steps, included with the Hybrid3 Edition, give you both a safe easy way to enter and exit, and a cover for your Energy Saver equipment.



Available as an option, the LEEP Portable Step gives you an easy way to enter and exit your hot tub.

PLANNING YOUR DELIVERY ROUTE SAVES TIME

Take the time to sketch out a quick map for the delivery people when they deliver your hot tub. A map like this is invaluable, to plan the route and to ensure they follow your instructions when they arrive. For some deliveries, the new owner may not be home during the delivery. A little communication goes a long way to help things run smoothly!

Measure the width of stairs and step to get up and over

Are there railings in the way, and how wide apart are they

Measure to see if shrubs or trees are an obstacle

Ensure sidewalks are free of objects and clutter

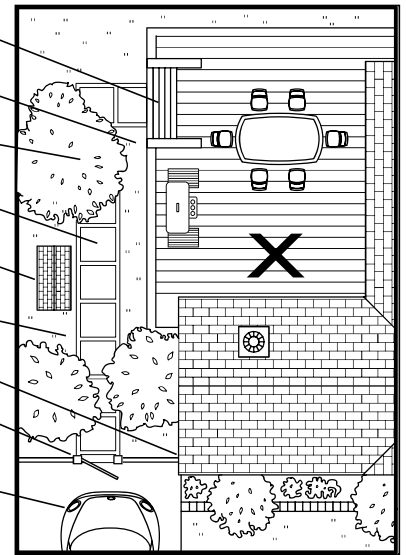
Check the doghouse or shed to see clearance available

Check for uneven ground or slippery slopes

Measure for overhanging gutters or downspouts

Gate measurement for clearance

Recreational vehicles and cars in the driveway

All Beachcomber Hot Tubs are hand built products. Because of this, dimensions can vary slightly from hot tub to hot tub. Before cutting a hole in your deck or pouring concrete, make sure your new hot tub is on hand to give you the exact dimensions.

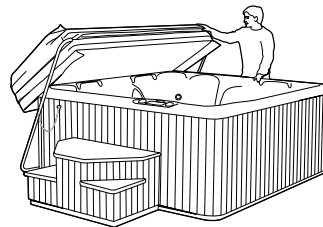
